What is Epilepsy?

Epilepsy is a condition of the brain that is characterized by recurrent seizures. Epilepsy is a seizure disorder, not a psychological disorder. Epilepsy is **not** a disease and is **not** contagious. In most cases, there is no known cause. In about 35% of cases, there are a number of identifiable causes, such as stroke, brain trauma or tumour, infection, developmental disorder, birth injury, etc.

Who is Affected by Epilepsy?

Epilepsy can affect anyone, at any time, at any age. One in every hundred of the general population of Canada has epilepsy, over 22,000 people living in Greater Edmonton and Northern Alberta, and over 330,000 people in Canada as a whole. Many great people in history have lived with Epilepsy, proving that having Epilepsy is not a barrier to achievement.

What is a Seizure?

Seizures are produced by excessive electrical discharges occurring in the nerve cells of the brain. Most people are familiar with a convulsive (grand mal or tonic clonic) seizure, but there are many other types of seizures. A seizure can take many different forms, including a blank stare, muscle spasms, uncontrolled movements, altered awareness, odd sensations, or a convulsion. Seizures may occur rarely, or several times a day. For over 70% of people with epilepsy, their seizures can be well controlled with anti-seizure medication.
